The Johnson City Fire Department (JCFD) is an advocate for Community Risk Reduction. One way our department is doing this is by offering smoke alarms for Johnson City residents at no cost. Statistics show the risk of dying in reported home structure fires is reduced by 55% by having working smoke alarms installed. The JCFD will provide the city resident with up to three (3) smoke alarms with 10-year maintenance-free batteries. If the resident needs assistance with the installation of the alarm(s), please contact us.

We recommend these alarms be placed outside of each bedroom and one on each floor of the residence. If you currently have smoke alarms installed that are over ten years old we recommend replacement. The sensors within the smoke alarm typically only last for ten (10) years. If you are unsure of the condition of your smoke alarm or have special needs, please contact us for assistance.
